SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITIES OF OFFICE OF DC(MSME) DURING JUNE 2008

1. IMPLEMENTATION OF MSMED ACT 2006

- (i) Considered views of Ministry of MSME on 35 items reserved for exclusive manufacture by MSE Sector were worked out and forwarded to PMO.
- (ii) The representation made by the members of the NBMSME was examined and views/comments of the O/o DC(MSME) were communicated to them.

2. IMPORTANT MEETINGS

The Department Related Parliament Standing Committee on Industry visited Chennai, Mumbai and Vishakhapatnam in the month of June 2008 to discuss the Credit Guarantee Scheme and Rural Employment Generation Programme with selected banks/KVIC. The meetings were attended by the officials from the Ministry of MSME.

3. IMPORTANT ACTIVITIES

- (i) The comments on application by the entrepreneurs / industrialists were provided to Department of IP&P on 370 Industrial Enterprises Memorandum (IEM), 10 Industrial Licenses (IL) and 11 Foreign Technology Cooperation (FTC).
- (ii) The proposal of restructuring and strengthening of DICs (particularly in view of the inclusion of service and medium sector, in accordance with MSMED Act 2006) constructed and followed up with IF Wing. The views expressed by IF

Wing are under consideration, before finalizing the concept paper for in principle approval of the Planning Commission.

- (iii) Commissioners /Directors of Industries, all States/UTs were apprised of the issues raised by President, Gujarat State Small Industries Federation, Ahmemdabad on matters related to delayed payments.

4. SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Field offices of DC (MSME) conducted 5 Entrepreneurship Development Programmes, 15 Skill Development Programmes, 33 Motivational Campaigns, 5 Management Development Programmes in which 4005 persons were trained.

Autonomous bodies of DC (MSME) conducted 95 Skill Development Programmes in which 8258 persons were trained.

5. TECHNOLOGY UPGRADATION

- (i) Central Institute of Tool Design, Hyderabad has provided assistance in design and manufacturing of tools & metrology and quality control to 61 small scale industries.
- (ii) Indo-Danish Tool Room, Jamshedpur successfully developed Stub Forging Dies and automobile components using hard metal machining method on newly purchased Makino Machining Centre for Tata Motors Ltd. Jamshedpur.
- (iii) 190 Job work were undertaken for 115 MSMEs by the autonomous bodies under DC (MSME).
- (iv) In MSME-TDC (Fragrance and Flavour Development Centre), Kannauj
 - (a) 148 samples of essential oils were analyzed
 - (b) 1532 Kg. essential oil/refused sandal wood powder/palmarosa oil were processed.
 - (c) 9 Kg .fragrance and flavour commercialized and

- (d) A project titled “studies on insect repellent fragrance” has been sponsored Defence Research Development Establishment (DRDE), Gwalior.

6. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR TECHNOLOGY UPGRADATION & MODERNISATION

During the month, application of 210 units amounting to Rs. 82.74 lakh have been processed for reimbursement
